Rosies Cars and Coffee Car Show Lloyds Donuts ---- March 1^t, 2025, Fremont




Goodguys 41st All American Get-Together----March 29&30th, 2025, Pleasanton



Celebrating the 60th anniversary of the 1965 "model" year

When it comes to collecting automobilia, some makes and models seem readily available, while others after all these years are left in the cold. For example, you can easily find some sort of signage, collectible, or artwork of a 1965 Mustang. However, it gets to be very difficult if you have a 1952 Pontiac Super Catilina SD or a 2009 Cobalt SS as such things are either not readily available, very rare, or exist. And then there is the 1965 Chevelle. This is an interesting one, because for the many trim levels and body styles these came in, only one gets the most attention...the Z16. More on that in a bit. Over the years there have been plastic model kits of their 1/1 counterparts known as promotional models that were used as a marketing tool. Today they are wonderful collectibles. In plastic, you can get the El Camino, Wagon, and the Chevelle usually in a 1/24 or 1/25 scale. The wagon kit that is pictured is an original release from AMT but has been re-issued multiple times as has the El Camino. The Chevelle from Revell though has only been offered as the Z16. In metal, there is a Chevelle SS made by Maisto. It is not a stock version but it's ok for what it is in 1/24. They also have an El Camino is well in 1/24. Muscle Machines offers a 1/24 scale wagon, but it's more of a Rat Fink/Toon style (exaggerated proportions) In metal for 1/18 scale there is the El Camino (Acme diecast) and the Z16 Chevelle (Ertl) There are other companies that offer the diecast Z16 as well. And in 1/64 scale Johnny lightning/Auto World, and Ertl. But as we see, there are very few Malibu and SS castings out there than there are the Z16 casting. But it is the most popular of the series. So, when it comes to the 1965 Chevelle model line, there is a large amount of representation out there...with the exception of the 300 deluxe and 4dr models. While these are really cool cars, unfortunately they have no representation in scale. At least at the time of this writing. Most of these can be ordered from websites like Modelroundup.com, DiecastModelWholesale.com, and DiecastDirect.com or there is the Amazon.com and eBay route as well for all your wonderful shopping needs.


